



Remember that old saying, " you get what you pay for." Well its true. Don't let the flashy cheap TV's draw you into buying one. That is what they are , cheap TV's. Most of these TV's are **Unrepairable**. These TV's are manufactured for sale only and do not have parts available when they break down. Or you may get a model TV that has to be packed up and shipped back to the manufacturer for exchange. For example, Westinghouse brand does not have any parts available and are telling their customers that you need to call the 800 number for "possible" exchange. Vizio is another brand that is becoming very popular, well make sure you save your box to ship it back to the manufacturer for repair and if the warranty is expired then you probably will end up paying double what you bought it for.

Stick to the brands you know, like Mitsubishi, LG and Samsung. These brands have US to repair them and parts availability for repair.
